## Friday "Hybrid" Tournament Information

#### Format/Schedule:

- Essentially, this is a hybrid of the AACS and Spectacular style quizzes.
- The Friday quiz will cover John 1-4 and 14-21.
- The morning will consist of placement/preliminary quizzes. Teams will then be split into three categories based on results (high, mid, low divisions).
- Afternoon quizzes will be three "mini-tournaments" based on preliminary results with the winner of each category winning a team trophy.
- Ten individual medals will be given to exceptional quizzers as well.

#### **Team Rosters:**

- Teams will have a maximum of 4 quizzers on the pads at a time. Teams can have fewer or more members on the team roster, but only four can quiz at a time.
- There is no age limit or experience level for quizzers participating in the Friday tournament.
- Quizzers must stay on the same team throughout the Friday competition.
- Rosters can consist of members from the same ministry or different ministries.

#### **Questions/Scoring:**

- Each quiz will consist of twenty unique questions for three team quizzing.
  - o Initial Errors will result in a same question tossup
  - No free questions will be asked if an error occurs on the tossup
- Each team starts with 40 points, but every error is -10.
- 20 points per correct answer; -10 points per error.
- Quiz outs = 4 answers per quizzer for quiz out (correct or incorrect, so be wary of errors).
- A team is quizzed out after 12 answers, regardless of number of quizzers on team.
- In the case of a tie after twenty questions, no tiebreaker question will be asked.
- Time limitations
  - o There is no 10-second requirement to begin the answer
  - 30 seconds are given for the quizzer to complete the answer once he is recognized.
- Time-outs
  - o There are no time-outs given to the teams in these quizzes.
  - The quizmaster will give the score after questions five, ten, fifteen, and nineteen.
- There are NO Challenges/Appeals in this event.
- Fouls: There are no fouls in this event. However, a team or single quizzer may be disqualified from the next question (light turned off) for:
  - Displaying an improper attitude.
  - Answering a question when the quizzer's light is not lit. If his teammate's light is on, the quizmaster will give an error to either the bad jumper or aggressive answerer.
  - Talking while a regular question is being asked or while a quizzer is recognized.
  - A coach or quizzer speaking out during quizzing or trying to influence the decision of the quizmaster.

Jumping before the question (including a tossup) has been asked. (For this situation, the "next" question is considered the tossup).

# General Tournament Information

**Quiz Masters:** Dave Douglas, David Poston, Cullen Baggett, Stephen VanGelderen (Friday only), and Dante Cardenas (Friday only).

- 1. There will be 5 **rooms** used for Quizzing:
  - The **Auditorium**
  - The **Fireplace** room
  - The **Children's** room (downstairs)
  - The **Toddler** room (downstairs)
  - The **Left Loft** room (upstairs)
- 2. For your convenience, a **nourishment room** is open in the kitchen area at all times at no cost to tournament participants, families, or fans. Everything is **free** to you, so please stay nourished, hydrated, and energized. (*There will be a short time when the kitchen area will be closed in order to set up for lunch. Please wait for prayer before heading through the lunch line.*)
- 3. **Lunch** will be through-the-line style. Lunch is for everyone attending the tournament as a participant or fan. No tickets or payments are needed. Due to the room situation, after you obtain your lunch, you may sit anywhere in the building where quizzing is not currently taking place (The Fireplace Room is a great option). Please be very careful with your drinks. Please be helpful and throw away your trash.
- 4. Quizzers for scoring purposes, please wear your **name cards** during every quiz so that the scorekeepers can see them. Every scorekeeper will need to identify your nametag quiz code.
- 5. After each quiz in the elimination rounds, the **next quiz information** will be posted on the screen in the upper church foyer area. Please move quickly and patiently to your next quiz room. You can also check the back of this booklet. (\*be aware: the elimination pre-bracket may have some unforeseen changes and is subject to change.)

Maintain right attitudes and quiz for the honor and glory of our Heavenly Father!

## Saturday Elite Tournament Rules

We will be using the AACS rules throughout the tournament with the following additions/exceptions:

The **format** for the CI 2021:

- There will be 4 **preliminary rounds** (all on Saturday morning).
- After the preliminary rounds end, all teams will be seeded into the **double- elimination rounds**.

#### 1. Teams:

Schools or Churches may have more than one team, but quizzers may not switch teams once quizzing has begun.

#### 2. Questions:

All Quizzes will end after 25 regular/tossup questions **or** 20 correctly answered questions — whichever comes first. The questions are designed to cover all 21 chapters in the Gospel of John (+4 random quote/finish the verse questions).

#### 3. Substitutions:

The number of substitutions in any quiz is unlimited; however, substitutions can only be made during a timeout (2 per team, per quiz) or for replacement of a quizzer who has quizzed out.

#### 4. Seeding:

Saturday (Elimination) Seeding will be based on a team's record during the preliminary matches. The best record is determined by:

1. Least number of losses 2. Greatest number of High Wins If ties are present after the final preliminary quizzes, seeding will be determined by head to head. Further tiebreakers are determined by the CI Staff (available

upon request).

Elimination bracketing: In the elimination rounds, byes will be determined based on:

- 1. Higher # of quizzes total
- 2. Highest Seeding Position after the preliminary rounds. (*This makes the early rounds actually worth something*)

#### 5. Finals:

When there is only one room remaining in the elimination rounds, scoring changes from "Elimination" to "Finals." This means that there is no 25-question limit: Quizzing continues until a 20th correct question is reached.

#### 6. Phones:

Quizzers may not use a phone at all during a quiz. Spectators are asked to turn off (or silence-not vibrate) their cell phones when in a quiz room. *Please no streaming if you are connected to the church's guest WIFI network.* 

#### 7. AACS Rules:

Reminder: A time-out can be called up to question 20. Also, fouls will be called for distracting or delaying the flow of a quiz. Challenges/Appeals can result in a reverse of scoring (I.e. error given, or 20 points awarded).






## Woodside Building Map
